"UNIVERSAL BELTED "NOTICE

- This is Universal Belted Enhanced Child Restraint System. It is approved according to UN RegulationNo. 129, for use primarily in "Universal seating positions" as indicated by vehicle manufacturers in the vehicle user's manual.
- If in doubt, consult either the Enhanced Child Restraint System manufacturer or the retailer.

"I - SIZE BOOSTER SEAT" NOTICE

- This is a i Size booster seat Enhanced Child Restraint System. It is approved according to UNRegulation No. 129 for use primarily in "i Size seating positions" as indicated by vehicle manufacturers in the vehicle user's manual.
- If in doubt, consult either the Enhanced Child Restraint System manufacturer or the retailer.

* DO NOT use the device in seating positions where an active frontal airbag installed.

02 SAFETY WARNING

- This product can be rearward-facing used by 5-point safety system for children with a height of 40-105cm (Weight: 0-18kg, about 0-4 years old), using adult three-point belt to fix the child restraint system;
- This product can also be forward-facing for children with a height of 100-150cm (Weight: 15-36kg, about 4-12 years old), using adult three-point belt to fix the child restraint system;
- Do not use any load bearing contact points other than those described in the instructions and marked in the child restraint,
- Please keep for furture reference, a storage compartment for the instructions is located on the back of the child seat;
- Do not use this child seat at home. It has not been designed for home use and should only be used in your car,
- Do not use rearward facing child seat in seating positions where there is an active frontal airbag installed, death or serious injury can occur;
- For the reason of safety, the child seat must be fixed inside the vehicle using adult three-point belt even if you do not put your child inside the child seat,
- The rigid items and plastic parts of a child seat shall be so located and installed that they are not liable, during everyday use of the vehicle to become trapped by a moveable seat or in a door of the vehicle;
- Any straps holding the restraint to the vehicle should be tight;
- Any straps restraining the child should be adjusted to the child's body;
- Straps should not be twisted;
- Ensure that any lap strap is worn low down, so that the pelvis is firmly engaged, shall be stressed;
- The device should be replaced when it has been subject to violent stresses in an accident;
- It's dangerous to make any alterations or additions to the device without the approval of the Type Approval Authority, also dangerous not to follow closely the installaton instructions provided by the manufacturer;
- When the seat is not provided with a textile cover, the seat should be kept away from sunlight, otherwise it may be too hot for the child's skin;
- Don't leave your child in the device unattended;
- Any luggage or other object liable to cause injuries in the event of a collision shall be properly secured;
- The seat cover should not be replaced with any other than the one recommended by the manufacturer, because the cover constitutes an intergral part of the restraint performance;


The instructions shall be retained on the device for its life period or in the vehicle handhook in the case of built-in restraints;

The user shall also be referred to the vehicle manufacturer's handhook;

Never use a second-hand product, as you can never be certain what happened to it.




3.1 Install position of the child seat in vehicle



Proper installation




Only suitable if the approved vehicles are fitted with 3 point safety-belt, approved to UN/ECE Regulation No.16 or other equivalent standards.



Not to use rearward-facing in seating positions where an active frontal airbag is installed.

Only use on this seat if a lap and diagonal seat belt is fitted.





As shown in the picture, you can adjust the headrest up and down by pulling on he headrest adjustment tab a , and adjust the headrest to a position suitable for the child's head.

3.3 Checking the shoulder strap height

Slightly higher

Always check that the shoulder straps are at the correct height for your child. The child's shoulder straps should always be threaded through the slots in the cover and seat shell that are closest to the top of your child's shoulders.

34 Usage of buckle



Buckle (sketch map)

Get the left and the right pieces of buckle together.

- Insert the two pieces into the slot of the buckle At the same time, hearing "click" means the buckle gets stuck, pull the pieces of the buckle and check whether the buckle is locked correctly.
- * If you want to release the safety belts, it needs to press the red button, then the pieces pop up.

3.5 Adjust the length of harness



 Loosen the shoulder strap 05 The shoulder strap can be slackened by pressing the adjuster (under the seat cover 10)on the front of the seat. Press down the adjuster as you grip the two shoulder straps with your another hand. Pull the harness towards you to loosen the shoulder strap.



- 3.6 Remove the shoulder strap

- Tighten the shoulder strap 05
 Pull the shoulder strap upward to remove the slack from the lap sections of the harness then pull the front stretch belt until the harness adjuster strap 12 is fully tightened.
 - * The shoulder strap should be adjusted as tightly as possible without causing discomfort to your child. A loose shoulder strap can be dangerous.
 - * Check the shoulder strap adjuster and tighten each time when the child is placed in the seat.


 Loosen the shoulder harness turn the child seat to the back. Slide the chest straps and shoulder straps off the harness connectors. (As shown in figure 1223)

3.7 Remove the Cheat pad and Cheat strap



Loosen the cloth cover inside the seat and adjust the headrest to the highest position (see page 5, 3.2 of the manual). Pull out the shoulder cover and shoulder strap from the headrest hole a as shown in Figure 1.

3.8 Remove the crotch pad and locker



Adjust the child seat to position 4 and turn it to the bottom. Turn the harness locking clip on their narrowest end and thread it through the slot under the bottom of the child seat. So the crotch pad and locker as well as harness straps can be removed.






 Method: Pull out the Boby Angle Adjuster 11 under the seat, adjust to the most inclined gear, and hear a sound of "click".



 Put the child seat rearward facing on the car seat and make sure that the front of the child seat is firmly pressed against the car seat backrest.





- Put your child into child seat.
- * Check the height of shoulder belts on the correctposition and fasten the buckle $\boxed{08}$.
- * Check that the harness has not been twisted.
- * Check that the cover is not impeding the movement or fit of the harness in anyway.

IMPORTANT:

The 3-point adult belt passes through the backrest as the picture shown:

 - * Make sure the car seat belt is not slack or twisted.
- * When using, it should be confirmed that the buckle of the adult 3-point belt does not interfere with the main load-bearing contact point of the child restraint system. If in doubt, pls contact the manufacturer of the child restraint system.



MAINTENANCE AND CLEANING

5.1 Daily maintenance

- In daily use, check periodically the child seat. The child seat should be replaced after an accident.
- Please keep this child seat in dry and ventilated place to avoid damp moldy.
- If the child seat becomes dusty, clean the seat belt and the plastic pieces by swiping them with a damp sponge and let it dry under ambiance.
- If food or drink drop accidently on the buckle, disassemble the seat belt from the child seat and rinse it gently by warm water. Leave it dry under ambiance.
- For cleaning the entire child seat fabric cover,please refer to the 5.2 washing instruction.

5.2 Washing instruction

Never use any solvent, chemical detergent or lubricant on any part of your child seat.





Dryclean, any solvent except trichloroethylene.
