I-SIZE ECRS NOTICE

This is an i-Size Enhanced Child Restraint System. It is approved according to UN Regulation No. 129, for use in i-Size compatible vehicle seating positions as indicated by vehicle manufacturers in the vehicle users' manual. If in doubt, consult either the Enhanced Child Restraint System manufacturer or the retailer.

"I-SIZE BOOSTER SEAT" NOTICE

This is a i-Size booster seat Enhanced Child Restraint System. It is approved according to UN Regulation No. 129, for use primarily in "i-Size seating positions" as indicated by vehicle manufacturers in the vehicle user's manual. If in doubt, consult either the Enhanced Child Restraint System manufacturer or the retailer.

- * DO NOT use forward facing before the child's age reaches 15 months.
- * Do not to use the ECRS in seating positions where an active frontal airbag is installed, death or serious injury may occur.

* In order to ensure the safety of your child, please read the instructions carefully to avoid dangerous situations!

This is a height of 40-150cm product, suitable for children from 0-36KG.

* DO NOT use forward facing before the child's age exceeds 15 months.

Precautions for product use

- This product can be rearward-facing used for children with a height of 40–105cm (Weight: 0–18kg), using ISOFIX +Top tether to fix the child restraint system;
- This product can also be forward-facing used by 5-point safety system for children with a height of 76–105cm (Weight: 9–18kg), using ISOFIX+Top tether to fix the child restraint system;
- This product can also be forward-facing used for children with a height of 100–150cm (Weight: 15–36kg), using adult three-point belt to fix the child restraint system, or using ISOFIX and adult three-point belt together to fix the child restraint system;
- Do not use any load bearing contact points other than those described in the instructions and marked in the child restraint when in 100–150cm;
- Please keep for future reference, a storage compartment for the instructions is located on the back of the child seat;
- Do not use this child seat at home. It has not been designed for home use and should only be used in your car;
- Do not use rearward facing child seat in seating positions where there is an active frontal airbag installed, death or serious injury can occur;
- For the reason of safety, the child seat must be fixed inside the vehicle using ISOFIX anchorages even if you do not put your child inside the child seat;
- The rigid items and plastic parts of a child seat shall be so located and installed that they are not liable, during everyday use of the vehicle to become trapped by a moveable seat or in a door of the vehicle;

- Any straps holding the restraint to the vehicle should be tight;
- Any straps restraining the child should be adjusted to the child's size;
- Straps should not be twisted;
- Ensure that any lap strap is worn low down, so that the pelvic bones are engaged, shall be stressed;
- The device should be replaced when it has been subject to severe stresses in an accident;
- It's dangerous to make any alterations or additions to the device without the approval of the Type Approval Authority, also dangerous not to follow closely the installation instructions provided by the manufacturer;
- When the child restraint is not provided with a textile cover, the child restraint should be kept away from sunlight, otherwise it may be too hot for the child's skin;
- Don't leave your child in the device unattended;
- Any luggage or other object liable to cause injuries in the event of a collision shall be properly secured;
- The ECRS shall not be used without the cover;
- The seat cover should not be replaced with any other than the one recommended by the manufacturer, because the cover constitutes an integral part of the restraint performance;
- The instructions shall be retained on the device for its life period or in the vehicle handbook in the case of built-in restraints;
- The user shall also be referred to the vehicle manufacturer's handbook;
- Never use a second-hand product, as you can never be certain what was happened to it.

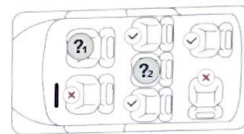
03 USAGE

3.1 Install position of the child seat in vehicle



- ✓ Proper installation ✗ Improper installation
- Only suitable for approved vehicles are fitted with 3 point seat belt, approved to UN/ECE Regulation No. 16 or equivalent standards.

ISOFIX Anchor points for car seats



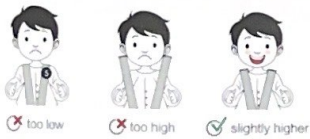
- ? Not to use in seating positions where an active frontal airbag is installed.
- ? Only use on this seat if ISOFIX anchorages are fitted

3.2 Adjust the headrest



- As shown in the picture, you can adjust the headrest up and down by pulling on the headrest adjustment tab ①, and adjust the headrest to a position suitable for the child's head.

3.3 Checking the shoulder strap height



- Always check that the shoulder straps ② are at the correct height for your child. The child's shoulder straps should always be threaded through the slots in the cover and seat shell that are closest to the top of your child's shoulders.

3.4 Usage of buckle



Buckle ③ (sketch map)

- Grab the left and the right pieces of buckle together.
- Insert the two pieces into the slot of the buckle. At the same time, hearing "click" means the buckle gets stuck, pull the pieces of the buckle and check whether the buckle is locked correctly.

* If you want to release the safety belts, it needs to press the red button, then the pieces pop up.

3.5 Adjust the length of harness



Loosen the harness

The harness can be slackened by pressing the adjuster (under the seat cover) on the front of the seat. Press down the adjuster as you grip the two harness with your another hand. Pull the harness towards you to loosen the harness.

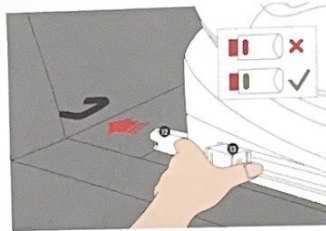
Tighten the harness

Pull the harness upward to remove the slack from the lap sections of the harness then pull the front stretch belt until the harness is fully tightened.

- The harness should be adjusted as tightly as possible without causing discomfort to your child. A loose harness can be dangerous.
- Check the harness adjuster and tighten each time when the child is placed in the seat.



3.6 Adjust the ISOFIX attachments



- The ISOFIX attachments can be adjusted for many positions to fit the different positions of ISOFIX low anchorages extending from car seat.
- Press down the release button to adjust ISOFIX attachment of both sides to the longest. Snap the ISOFIX into the ISOFIX Anchor points. Make sure that you have heard a "click" and the ISOFIX latching indication shows GREEN.

- If you want to release the ISOFIX attachments, just installation of the ISOFIX attachments is finished.
- Push the red release button of the ISOFIX chuck at the direction as shown, the ISOFIX chuck will be released.

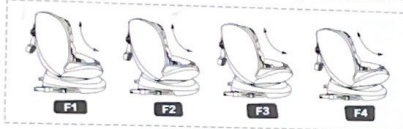


After installed the ISOFIX chuck, push the child restraint forwards until it is tight against the car seat. Now, the ISOFIX base is installed in place.

3.7 One click adjustment method: rotation & adjust gear



Pull back and forth to adjust the child seat to gear F1/F2/F3/F4.



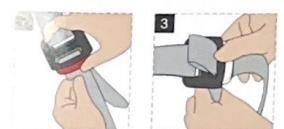
Rotate left and right, adjust the child seat to forward-facing (height: 76–105cm) or rearward-facing (height: 40–105cm). When the child seat is rearward-facing, it can also adjust to gear R1/R2/R3/R4.



3.8 Adjust method of top tether



○ Firstly, tear the storage Velcro (see 1);










○ Secondly, press and hold the button of the top tether adjuster (see 2) and release the top tether to the appropriate length (see 3);



○ Thirdly, hang the top tether connector to the top tether anchorage which recommended in the vehicle user manual;
○ Finally, tighten the top tether until the adjustment indicator shows green.

4 1 Installed rearward-facing



Usage : ISOFIX+Top tether
Height: 40-105cm

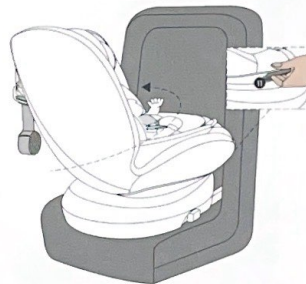


Step 1 /
Push ISOFIX on both sides of the base and clip it into the ISOFIX Anchor points. When a "click" is heard, the ISOFIX release button (1) is displayed in green color (2).



Step 2 /
Put the child in the safety seat, and lock the buckle (1), tighten the front tether (2).

*On the premise of not causing discomfort to children, tighten the shoulder belt as much as possible.
*The crotch strap should be as low as possible and should be located close to the crotch, not the abdomen.
*To ensure the comfort of your child, the safety belt must not be twisted.



Step 3 /
Turn the rotation adjuster (1) and adjust the 90° hover state to rearward-facing. The vehicle can only drive after hearing the "click" sound.

Pay attention!!
Do not drive when the safety seat in the location of 90° hover.




Step 4 /
Pull out the top tether strap to a suitable length, and then fix the top tether hook to the top tether (1) anchorage of the car seat

4.2 Installed forward-facing



Usage : ISOFIX+Top tether
Height: 76-105cm



Step 1 /
Push ISOFIX on both sides of the base and clip it into the ISOFIX Anchor points. When a "click" is heard, the ISOFIX release button **(1)** is displayed in green color ().



Step 2 /
Put the child in the safety seat, and lock the buckle **(2)**, tighten the front tether **(3)**.

*On the premise of not causing discomfort to children, tighten the shoulder belt as much as possible.
*The crotch strap should be as low as possible and should be located close to the crotch, not the abdomen.
*To ensure the comfort of your child, the safety belt must not be twisted.



Step 3 /
Pull out the top tether strap to a suitable length, and then fix the top tether hook to the top tether anchorage of the car seat.

4.3 Installed forward-facing



Usage : ① ISOFIX + 3 point belt
Height: 100–150cm

- Push ISOFIX on both sides of the base and clip it into the ISOFIX Anchor points. When a "click" is heard, the ISOFIX release button ① is displayed in green color.
- Put the child into the safety seat, adjust the headrest up and down according to the height of child.
- Pull out the adult 3-point belt, Clip the vehicle shoulder belt into the belt guide hook of ② the headrest, and then clip vehicle shoulder and lap belt together into the belt guide slot on the side of the seat, finally lock the buckle.



Usage : ② only 3 point belt
Height: 100–150cm

■ Shoulder belt ■ Lap belt

- Put the child into the safety seat, adjust the headrest up and down according to the height of child.
- Pull out the adult 3-point belt, Clip the vehicle shoulder belt into the belt guide hook of ② the headrest, and then clip vehicle shoulder and lap belt together into the belt guide slot on the side of the seat, finally lock the buckle.



* When using, it should be confirmed that the buckle of the adult 3-point belt does not interfere with the main load-bearing contact point of the child restraint system. If in doubt, pls contact the manufacturer of the child restraint system.

05 MAINTENANCE AND CLEANING

5.1 Daily maintenance

- In daily use, check periodically the child seat. The child seat should be replaced after an accident.
- Please keep this child seat in dry and ventilated place to avoid moldy.
- If the child seat becomes dusty, clean the seat base and the plastic pieces by swiping them with a damp sponge and let it dry under ambience.
- If food or drink drop accidentally on the buckle, disassemble the seat belt from the child seat and rinse it gently by warm water. Leave it dry under ambience.
- For cleaning the entire child seat fabric cover, please refer to the 5.2 washing instruction.

5.2 Washing instruction

* Never use any solvent, chemical detergent or lubricant on any part of your child seat.



5.3 Remove and assemble the fabric cover

Disassembly step



1. Unlock the buckle

2. Take off the cushion

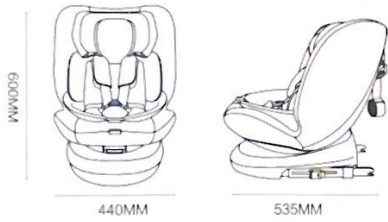
3. Open both shoulder sleeves

4. Remove the cover on the headrest

Finally, remove the cloth cover along the edge of the seat

* If you want to reinstall the cloth cover, please follow the reverse steps **1 2 3 4** to install.

THE MAIN TECHNICAL PARAMETERS



- o Distance from front to back of the seat:535mm
- o Distance form left to right of the seat:440mm
- o Height of the seat:600mm

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
